THE SEVEN COMPLEX LESSONS ON EDUCATION OF THE FUTURE

CONFERENCE HELD IN BRASIL CHAIRED BY EDGAR MORIN

Ten years after presenting to the international community the work *The Seven complex lessons in Education of the Future*, produced under the guidance of Professor Edgar Morin, UNESCO has convened a Conference to study its potential impact at the beginning of this century. The Conference has been organized and developed in collaboration with the authorities of the State of Ceará, the Department of Science, Technology and Higher Education, the Catholic University of Brasilia, the State University of Ceará and the KIP Scientific Committee for human development cooperation.

The Conference, chaired by Professor Edgar Morin, was held in Fortaleza, capital of Ceará State, from 21 to 24 September, 2008. 1,300 participants attended the event, besides having established links with more than 10,000 web conferences hubs, both in Brazil and abroad. About 17 countries followed and accompanied the development of the work.
